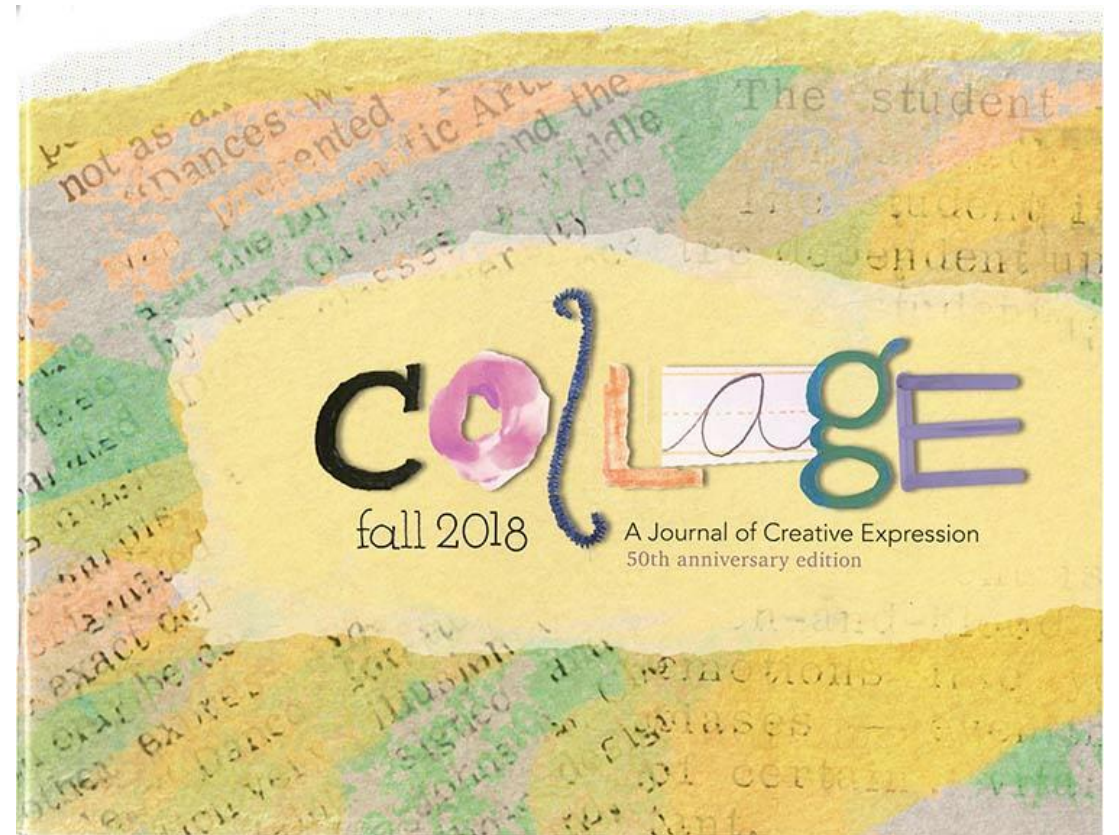
How can I work on the staff?
