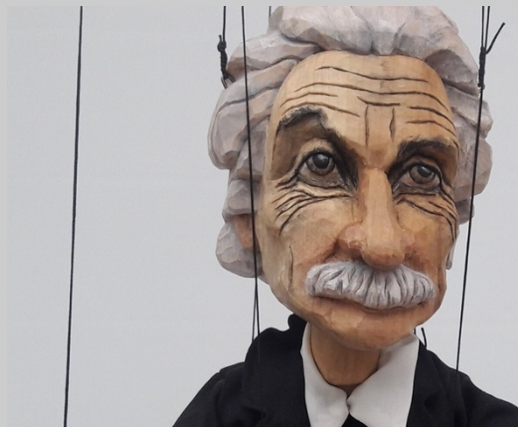

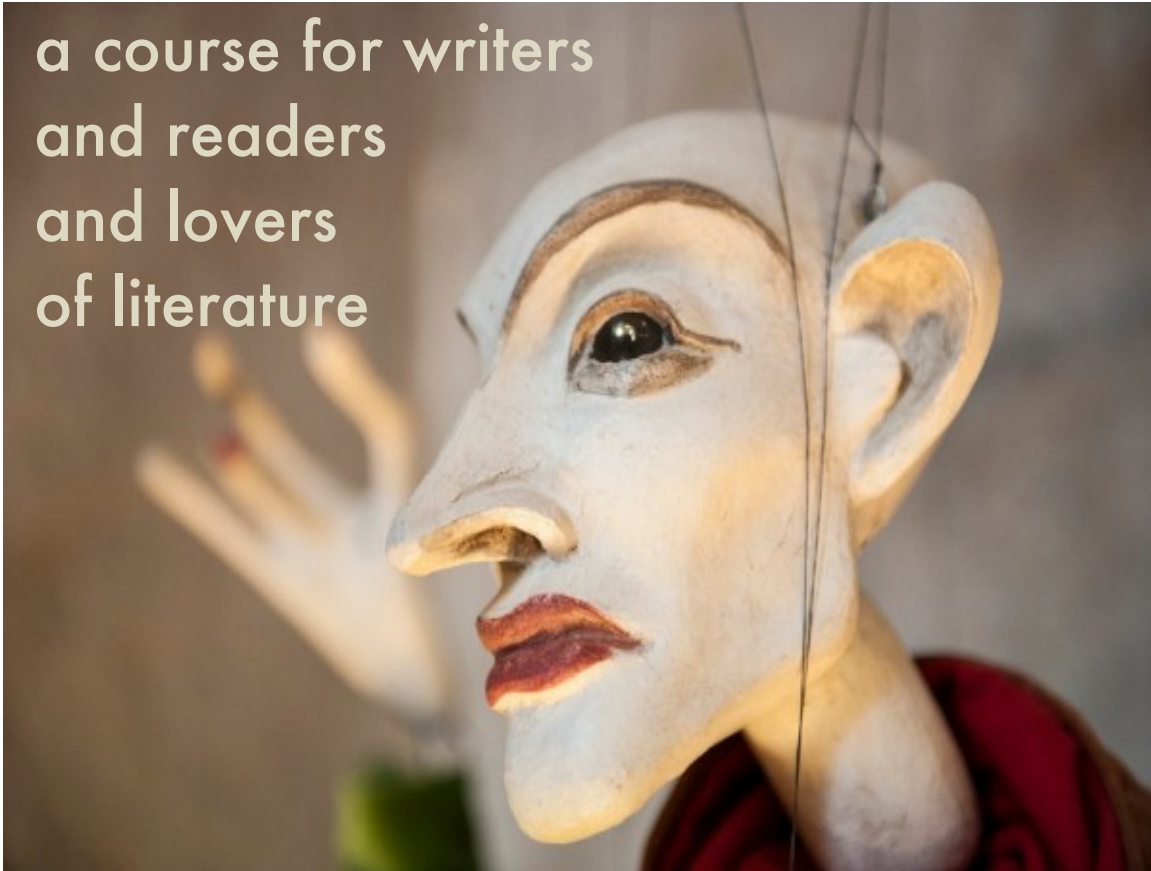
Fall 2025: English 3625 and English 3625-Honors
